### GLOSSARY

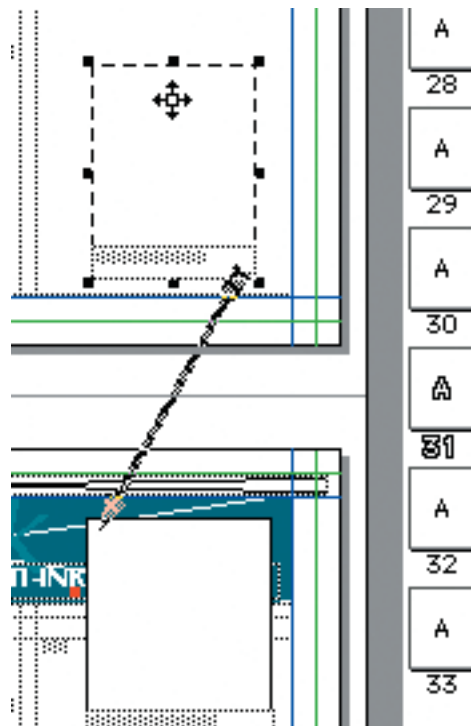
**Continued from line A** A line that shows the page number of the previous linked text box.

**Continued on line A** A line that shows the page number of the next linked text box.

When a story in a newspaper or magazine continues from one page onto another page, you see continued on and continued from references. These are called “jump lines”.

Quark can create continued on and continued from references that update automatically using a combination of grouped text boxes and keyboard commands. You need at least two text boxes for each section of the story, with one containing the story and the other containing the reference text.

Create two text boxes and link them. These boxes will contain the story. Create two smaller text boxes to contain the continued on page and continued from page references. Enter the wording for your reference and format it as you see fit.



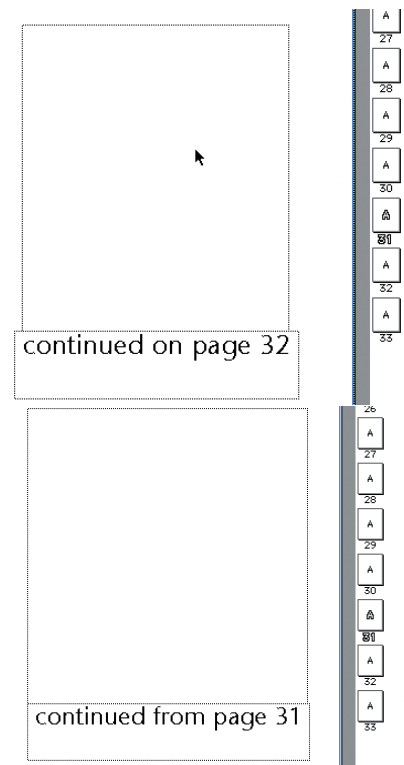
**A** Linked text boxes

With the Item tool selected, place the reference boxes within the story boxes. You could place the continued on page at the bottom of the first story box and the continued from page at the top of the next story box.

Select each set of boxes and group them.

After the “continued on page”, enter the Next Box Page Number character by pressing Command-4. After the “continued from page”, enter the Previous Box Page Number character by pressing Command-2.

Move the grouped text boxes to separate pages and the “continued” references will automatically update.
